

General Field Trip Permission Form: 2010-2011

Field trips are an extension of classroom instruction. They help to illustrate and reinforce concepts learned in the classroom. Field trips are for instructional purposes and help make learning real. All students are expected to attend school-sponsored field trips. If they do not attend, they will be required to report to school and be given regular assignments related to items covered on the field trip.

Parents and other teachers must be informed of all field trips in advance. This form is intended to assist in this effort and is required for all regular day trips during the normal school day. It is kept on file by the school and provides evidence to teachers and the school administration of parental approval for student participation in such field trips. It is also utilized for the school's insurance coverage at the time of such trips.

Special events or activity trips, i.e. swimming, horseback riding, boat trips, and any and all off-island travel, will require a separate form for specific travel permission. This form is sent to parents prior to the realization of such events or activities.
